

## 2023-24 Streamline Aquatics Registration Process

## **New Swimmers:**

**STEP 1:** Complete the Tryout Form on the Streamline website to schedule a tryout. **All New Swimmers Must Have** an **Evaluation prior to registration to be placed in the proper group.**

STEP 2: After you have received your group assignment, complete the Streamline DocuSign Registration Forms.

Please note you should use the <a href="Parent/Legal Guardian Name">Parent/Legal Guardian Name</a> to sign on to DocuSign. We must have a <a href="Parent/Legal Guardian Signature">Parent/Legal Guardian Name</a> on the forms as we cannot accept forms signed by minors.

If you have more than one athlete on the team, simply sign in again to complete forms for any additional athlete(s) members.

## **Complete the Docusign Registration Form Here**

- STEP 3: Email a copy or an image of the athlete's birth certificate or passport to <a href="mailto:paysasa@sbcglobal.net">paysasa@sbcglobal.net</a>
  If the athlete is "new" to Streamline Aquatics, but has previously been registered with another USA Swimming Team, please complete a Transfer Form, and email it to <a href="mailto:paysasa@sbcglobal.net">paysasa@sbcglobal.net</a>.
- **STEP 4:** Once your membership registration with Streamline Aquatics has been processed you will be provided with a personalized link to complete the membership registration process with USA Swimming. Please allow 2-5 business days after submitting your DocuSign Registration Forms for additional information to be sent to you.
- STEP 5: Use the personalized link to complete and pay for the membership registration with USA Swimming.
- **STEP 6:** Email the athlete's name and new USA ID Number to <a href="mailto:paysasa@sbcglobal.net">paysasa@sbcglobal.net</a>. Submitting the new USA ID Number is how SASA will know that you have registered with USA Swimming and are allowed to train with Streamline Aquatics.
