Parents Guide to Misconduct in Sport

This course educates parents on recognizing, responding to, and preventing abuse and misconduct in their child's sport setting.

Parents are required to take the "Parent Guide to Misconduct in Sport" course. To access the course, parent's must log in to their individual USA Swimming account and link to their child who is a registered member of the team. This linking process ensures that the club gets the credit upon the parent's completion of the course.

Parents should be aware that the course has an expiration date, which can be viewed on their USA Swimming account. The course should be taken once every 18 months.

Furthermore, it is important to note that the course requires retaking whenever the club intends to renew their Safe Sport Club Recognition status.
